about your identity.**

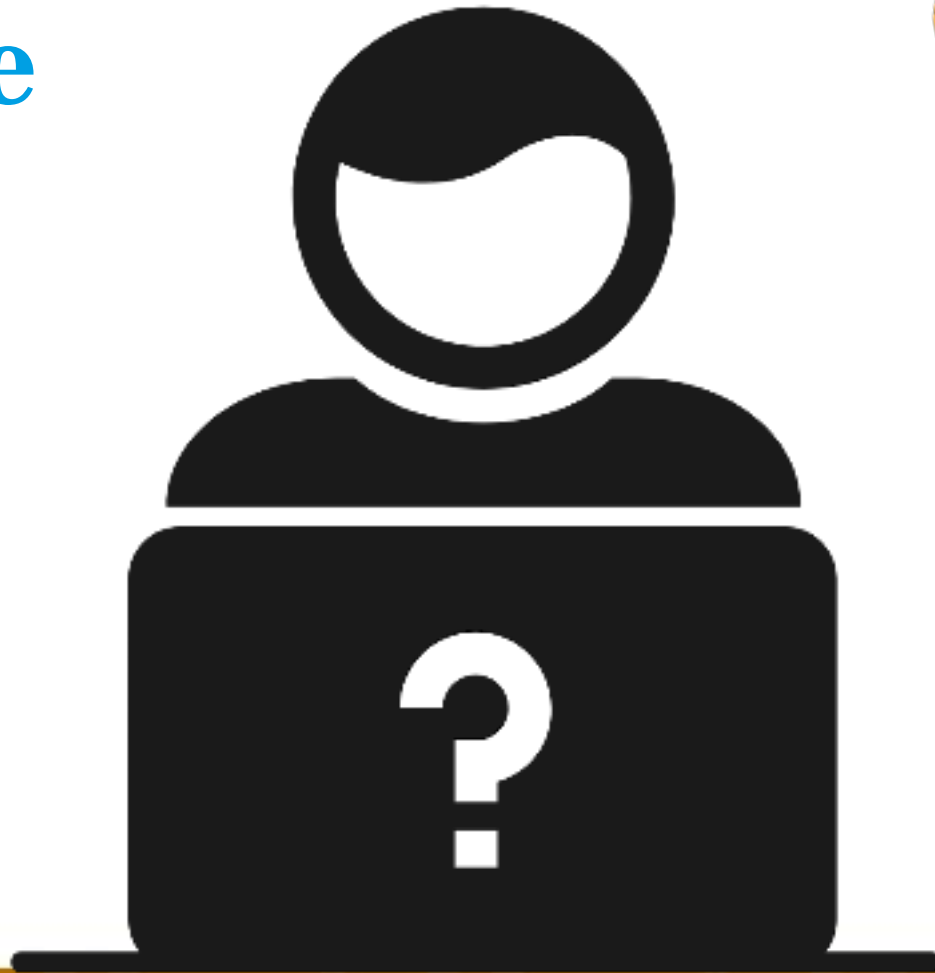
